What data do we collect?

Our Company collects the following data:

Personal identification information (Name, email address, phone number, etc.)

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide Our Company with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

Register online or place an order for any of our products or services.

Voluntarily sign-up to our mailing list, complete a customer survey or provide feedback on any of our message boards or via email.

Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.

Our Company may also receive your data indirectly from the following sources:

Where we provide services to other businesses and process your data on their behalf to fulfil any contractual obligations to that business.

Under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the lawful bases we rely on for processing this information are:

- Your consent. You are able to remove your consent at any time. You can do this by contacting [contact details]
- We have a contractual obligation.
- We have a legal obligation.
- We have a legitimate interest.

How will we use your data?

Our Company collects your data so that we can:

Process your order and manage your account.

Email you with special offers on other products and services we think you might like.

If you agree, Our Company will share your data with our partner companies so that they may offer you their products and services.

Vendors and 3rd parties involved with delivering any part of a project which you have contracted our involvement.

Where you opt to visit referral links from our websites, where information is required to complete any associated purchase or account creation.

When Our Company processes your order, it may send your data to, and also use the resulting information from, credit reference agencies to prevent fraudulent purchases.

How do we store your data?

Our Company securely stores your data using trusted 3rd party enterprise solutions for example Microsoft Business 365 for email and file storage and MongoDB Atlas database services. We use secure passwords that meet the minimum requirements set out by the vendor.

we keep your personal information only for as long as required by us:

- While you have an active account or subscription with us.
- to provide you with the services you have requested.
- to comply with other law, including for the period demanded by our tax authorities.
- to support a claim or defence in court.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to Our Company's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request that Our Company transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.
